



## International Study Centre (ISC) Accommodation Information 11-12



Thank you for deciding to take your course at Heriot-Watt University and for selecting residential accommodation.

All students have use of a lounge, launderette, 24 hour computer labs, and a warden in each hall who will be there to help you settle in and sort out any problems you may have. There is broadband access in every room included in the weekly rent.

Most students will be housed in an en-suite self-catered residence block:

### **En-suite, Self-Catered £103.93 per week.**

Our en-suite accommodation is comprised of study bedrooms which are grouped around kitchens for the use of a maximum of 5 students. Each room has a private toilet, shower and washbasin. The kitchen and dining areas are furnished but no cooking utensils, crockery or cutlery is provided.

For some intakes students may be housed in standard, catered residences:

### **Standard, Catered £119.84 to £131.27 per week.**

Our standard accommodation is comprised of 5 or 6 students per floor sharing toilets and shower rooms. There is a washbasin in every room, and access to a lounge and a pantry. The pantry is an area where you can prepare a snack, but is not suitable for cooking main meals. Your weekly rent includes a catering allowance of £52.50 to spend on food and beverages (not alcohol). Your catering card can be used at a variety of catering outlets across campus.

Please note – accommodation prices noted are based on guideline rents for 11/12, and are subject to change.

**Students staying in on-campus residences must pay an Accommodation Confirmation Payment when confirming their place on the course, and within residences. This payment is for £2000 and covers all deposits and sundries, you will be expected to pay the remainder of your rent as per the universities terms and conditions. Bedding packs are not included in the cost but will be available to purchase in centre for around £20.**

**All accommodation deadlines which are set by the university must be adhered to and Study Group cannot guarantee accommodation to late applicants.**

### **Suitable for Short Term Options, such as early arrivals:**

If you have informed Study Group of your need for a short stay room our centre staff can pre-book you a room on-campus in a conference room. The guideline cost of the conference rooms is £30-40 per night.
