



Thank you for deciding to take your course at Keele University and for selecting residential accommodation.

For ISC students, the university offers 3 types of accommodation, across 3 different residences, all of which are university managed. Below is an outline of each type of accommodation available. For more information please visit the Student Accommodation Lettings Service website:

All rooms are self-catered, and there is a telephone provided, which can receive and make local and international calls. The internet is available in all rooms, the price of which is included in the room rate. All residences also have a non-alcoholic social area.

Hawthorns Hall
Standard Single Room, including wash basin
£78.80 per week

Hawthorns Hall is situated on the east fringe of the campus where Keele Village road cuts across the extremity of the campus. Over 600 students live in a variety of residences.

Facilities include:

- Restaurant
- Shop
- Television and games room
- Student bar
- Card and coin pay telephones

There is a launderette, cycle store and car park within the hall boundary. The close proximity to Keele Village gives the added bonus of being able to use the village amenities.

The number of rooms within each standard residence varies. There is a communal kitchen area, and bathroom facilities shared between 7 students.

Barnes Hall
En-suite Single Room
£108.40 per week

Barnes Hall is situated on the north end of the campus ring road, housing approximately 650 students, plus a general block, which is home to the student bar with adjacent launderette. Halls facilities include:

- Student bar
- Launderette
- Cycle store
- Card and coin pay telephones

All rooms are en-suite, with kitchen facilities shared between 6 students.

The Oaks
Premier En-suite Room
£114.90 per week

The Oaks is situated to the south-west of the campus and has 419 rooms and a cycle store.

The Premier study bedroom includes upgraded shower facilities, and a queen size bed.

The kitchen facilities are also updated, and shared between 4 students.

Please note – accommodation prices noted are based on guideline rents for 11/12, and may be subject to change.

Students staying in on-campus residences must pay an Accommodation Confirmation Payment when confirming their place on the course, and within residences. This payment is for £2000 and covers all deposits and sundries, such as bedding packs which are provided for you. You will be expected to pay the remainder of your rent as per the universities terms and conditions.

All accommodation deadlines which are set by the university must be adhered to and Study Group cannot guarantee accommodation to late applicants.
